NORTH

Betty & Wilbur Davis State Park, 133 Davis Road, Schenevus, Andy's Trail (2.7 miles) Hiking *Date/Notes:*

Brookwood Point Conservation Area, 6000 State Hwy 80, Cooperstown Walking, Paddling *Date/Notes:*

Clark Tower Trails, Beaver Meadow Road, Middlefield, NY (.3 miles from County Route 52) Unmarked trails, choose your distance *Date/Notes:*

Fetterley Forest, 302 Roses Hill Rd., Richfield Overlook-Forest-Vernal Pond Trails (1 mile) Hiking *Date/Notes:*

Glimmerglass State Park, 1527 County Hwy 31, Cooperstown Sleeping Lion Trail (2 miles) *Date/Notes:*

Goodyear Swamp Sanctuary on Otsego Lake, 7300 State Hwy 80, Cooperstown (park across from the Glimmerglass Festival, cross the street and follow road south of buildings to trailhead. Watch for poison ivy.) 1 mile *Date/Notes:*

Robert B. Woodruff Outdoor Learning Center, 2316 NY-80, Jordanville (enter north of Owen D. Young Central School) (1.25 miles) Note: Trail may be closed until 3:30 pm on weekdays for school summer program. *Date/Notes:*
